FEMA NOTICE OF INTENT GRANT:

FEMA GRANT AVAILABLE TO HELP REMOVE VILLAGE FLOOD ISSUES AT VILLAGE HALL, GIMLET CREEK AND THEINUS CREEK. WORK WOULD POSSIBLY START WINTER OF 2024. THE VILLAGE WOULD BE RESPONCIBLE FOR A \$2,500 APPLICATION FEE. TOTAL PROJECT C OST IS \$630,000 THE FEDERAL GRANT REQUEST IS \$472,500. THE VILLAGE SHARE WOULD BE \$157,500. KEVIN LINDERMAN WITH NCICG WILL LOOK INTO THE POSSIBILTY OF ANOTHER GRANT TO HELP WITH THE VILLAGE SHARE. THE BOARD DISCUSSED POSSIBLE CHUNKING OF THE PROJECT AND DOING WORK IN PHASES TO CUT DOWN ON VILLAGE COST. IN OCTOBER THE BOARD WILL MAKE A DECSION AS WHETHER TO GO FORWARD WITH GRANT, AND DISCUSS ANY RFQ'S THAT ARE SUBMITTED.
